**BRISCO ROAD AT US 101 NORTHBOUND ON AND OFF-RAMPS
REOPENING AFTER THE TEMPORARY TEST CLOSURE**

ARROYO GRANDE, CALIFORNIA – On Tuesday, November 22, 2016, the Arroyo Grande City Council approved the conclusion of the Test Closure of the Brisco Road at US 101 northbound on and off-ramps and directed the opening of the ramps in coordination with Caltrans.

Opening the ramps will require clean-up, restriping of the pavement markings and removal of the temporary barricades. This work will necessitate a temporary closure of the Highway 101 Brisco Rd underpass. R. Burke Corporation, a contractor hired by the City of Arroyo Grande, will be closing the Brisco Road/Highway 101 underpass between El Camino Real and West Branch Street at 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 17, 2017 in order to begin work to re-open the Brisco Road on and off ramps. The work is anticipated to be complete with both ramps open by 5:00 a.m. on January 18, 2017, in advance of peak commuter traffic.
