**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a public hearing on **TUESDAY, JANUARY 25, 2022 at 6:00 p.m.**, or soon thereafter, to consider the following item:

**CONSIDERATION OF APPEAL TO CITY COUNCIL CASE 21-006; APPEAL OF PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVAL OF PLOT PLAN REVIEW 21-033 FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A VACATION RENTAL; LOCATION; 263 SPRUCE ST, UNIT D; APPELLANT – SHARON VALIENZI**

The City Council will consider an appeal of the Planning Commission's denial of Appeal Case 21-005, which upheld the Community Development Director's approval of Plot Plan Review 21-033 to establish a vacation rental in an existing residence in the Multi-Family zoning district.

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Community Development Department has determined the project is categorically exempt per Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines regarding existing facilities.

Due to concerns regarding the COVID-19 pandemic, the City of Arroyo Grande is conducting all public meetings via teleconference, until further notice. The City Council meeting can be viewed on Government Access Channel 20. During the public hearing, public comment will be limited to three (3) minutes per speaker, pursuant to current meeting procedure.

The City Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
