

Private Venues and Events Checklist COVID-19 Health Guidelines for California

This document is designed to help event organizers understand what rules are required for private venues and events in San Luis Obispo County. Private Venues and Events are distinguished from Gatherings in that Private Venue and Events must have defined guest lists and the ability to assign seating for guests. Please review the State's Private Venue and Event Guidance for full details.

- Fully vaccinated people may be seated at full capacity and people do not need to physically
 distance from each other, but face coverings are required. For guidance relating to fully

 Vaccinated People</u>.
- For guidance relating to religious services, see <u>COVID-19 Industry Guidance: Places of Worship and Providers of Religious Services and Cultural Ceremonies</u>.

This checklist does NOT replace a prepared plan to support a safe, clean environment for workers, performers, volunteers, and patrons. This checklist also does not apply to convention-style events, general admission venues, and events where the central activity allows patrons to move around shared space.

Live entertainment will follow all relevant guidance for Outdoor Seated Live Events and Performances Guidance or Indoor Seated Live Events and Performances. Physical distancing between vendors, officiants, and other event workers or attendees will be maintained.

	Face coverings are required, unless actively eating or drinking. See <u>CDPH Guidance on Face</u> <u>Coverings</u> .
	Attendance is limited to a pre-determined guest list of no more than (choose one): o 100 people (if event is outdoor only).
	 300 people if all attendees show proof of negative test or full vaccination (if outdoors). 150 people if all attendees show proof of a negative test or full vaccination (if indoors). Attendance limit includes all staff and volunteers working at the event who do not participate in weekly COVID-19 testing or are not fully vaccinated.
	Assigned seating is required.
	Entrances and exits are tightly controlled to prevent concentrations of people. This event follows all dining and food service guidance under the Orange Tier.
	Live entertainment will follow all relevant guidance for Outdoor Seated Live Events and
	Performances Guidance or Indoor Seated Live Events and Performances. Physical distancing between vendors, officiants, and other event workers or attendees will be maintained.
Yello	w Tier
	Face coverings are required, unless actively eating or drinking. See <u>CDPH Guidance on Face</u> <u>Coverings</u> .
	Attendance is limited to a pre-determined guest list of no more than (choose one):
	 200 people (<i>if event is outdoor only</i>). 400 people if all attendees show proof of negative test or full vaccination (<i>if outdoors</i>).
	o 200 people if all attendees proof of a negative test or full vaccination (if indoors).
	Attendance limit includes all staff and volunteers working at the event who do not participate in weekly COVID-19 testing or are not fully vaccinated.
	Assigned seating is required.
	Entrances and exits are tightly controlled to prevent concentrations of people.
	This event follows all dining and food service guidance under the Yellow Tier. Live entertainment will follow all relevant guidance for Outdoor Seated Live Events and
	Performances Guidance or Indoor Seated Live Events and Performances.
	Physical distancing between vendors, officiants, and other event workers or attendees will be maintained.

200 people if all attendees proof of negative test or full vaccination (outdoor only).
100 people if all attendees proof of a negative test or full vaccination (if indoors).
