





NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

On **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 25, 2014**, the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at **215 E. BRANCH STREET** to consider the following item:

PUBLIC ART - STAFF PROJECT 14-006; CHUMASH ARBORGLYPH SCULPTURE AT 126 SOUTH MASON STREET; APPLICANT: ARROYO GRANDE IN BLOOM - PUBLIC ART COMMITTEE. The City Council will consider approval of a public art proposal located at 126 South Mason Street adjacent to the Heritage House Historical Museum. Prior to the meeting, the art proposal was referred to a public art panel in accordance with the City's Public Art Guidelines. This hearing will provide an opportunity for the community to comment on the proposal.

The City Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Comments may be either: (1) mailed or delivered in person to the Community Development Department at 300 East Branch Street, Arroyo Grande, CA or (2) provided in person at the Public Hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
