



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

On **TUESDAY, DECEMBER 9, 2014**, the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at **215 E. BRANCH STREET** to consider the following item:

GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT 14-002, SPECIFIC PLAN AMENDMENT 14-001, CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 14-009, AND VESTING TENTATIVE TRACT MAP 14-001; APPLICANT: MFI LIMITED & NKT COMMERCIAL; LOCATION: SOUTHWEST CORNER OF EAST GRAND AVENUE AND SOUTH COURTLAND STREET. The City Council will consider an amendment to the General Plan Land Use Element and to the Berry Gardens Specific Plan, Subarea 3; applications to subdivide approximately 4.47 acres of vacant land and a Conditional Use Permit to develop two (2) commercial buildings totaling approximately 11,000 square-feet, four (4) second-story, mixed-use condominiums above one commercial building, and forty-one (41) detached, small lot single-family residences. In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Community Development Department has prepared a draft Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the project.

The City Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Comments may be either: (1) mailed to or hand delivered to the Community Development Department, 300 East Branch Street, Arroyo Grande, CA 93420; or (2) provided in person at the public hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
