



2015 Street Resurfacing Project City of Arroyo Grande

August 4, 2015

Dear Residents,

American Asphalt South, Inc., under contract to the City of Arroyo Grande, will apply a slurry seal surfacing application on the streets listed on the reverse side of this notice between Monday, August 10th and Thursday, August 13th. Slurry seals are a mixture of sand and oil that essentially acts as a membrane to seal the roadway surface, helping to prevent moisture penetration and asphalt deterioration.

Prior to commencing work on your street, you will receive a notification flyer from American Asphalt South, Inc. with more specific information concerning the time frame that you can expect the work to be performed on your street. American Asphalt South, Inc. will also place informational barricades on your street advising you of the specific dates and locations of parking restrictions. Please note that although the barricade may say "7 AM to 6 PM", the actual slurry seal placement may occur at any time within that range. Parking on the street will not be allowed before, during, and up to 4 hours following the slurry seal placement. Please refrain from driving on the wet slurry seal application until the street has been officially reopened as driving on the wet slurry seal product may adversely affect the appearance and function of the slurry seal and may result in paint damage to your vehicle.

The street may appear rough in nature following the application of slurry seal due to loose gravel and slight differences in the placement thickness of the slurry seal mixture. The roughness will lessen after several weeks of normal traffic flow. The majority of the gravel that does not adhere to the mixture will work loose in the first several days. American Asphalt South, Inc. will perform a final sweeping after several days to clean up any additional gravel or debris that may have worked loose. Visual discoloration should subside following several weeks of exposure with sunlight. Striping operations, if applicable, will follow ten days after the slurry seal placement.

The City of Arroyo Grande hopes this information addresses your concerns. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me or stop by the Corporation Yard, located at 1375 Ash Street. The City of Arroyo Grande apologizes for any inconvenience that this work may cause to your daily activities.
