Does your child show signs of being an artist, or enjoy drawing and painting? The City of Arroyo Grande Recreation Services Department and Peggy Valko are offering art classes for students who would like to learn or improve their drawing and painting skills. The Art for Kids class for 5-12 year olds is designed to promote hand/eye coordination, build self-confidence, and increase problem solving abilities. Subject matter includes animals, people, still life, abstract, and landscapes. Media includes markers, graphite, watercolor, pastels, acrylic paints, charcoal, colored pencils and crayons.

The class is ongoing Wednesdays, January through May at Peggy's Art Studio, 809 East Grand in Arroyo Grande. Ages 5 to 7 will meet from 3:15 - 4:15 p.m. followed by 8 to 12 year olds from 4:30 – 5:45 p.m. The cost is \$42.00 for four lessons and includes all materials.
