This class is for students who know how pieces move and will be held on Mondays, January 11th - March 21st from 1:30-2:30 p.m. or 3:30-5:00 p.m.; or Saturdays, January 16th - February 27th from 2:00-4:00 p.m. Classes will take place at the First United Methodist Church located at 275 N. Halcyon Rd., Room 211, Arroyo Grande.

The fee for the classes is \$66 for the first child and \$33 for additional sibling per session. These classes have a minimum, so sign up early! Registration is available online at arroyogrande.org or in person at the Arroyo Grande Recreation Services Office at 1221 Ash Street in Arroyo Grande.
