



On **TUESDAY, MARCH 8, 2016**, the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at **215 E. BRANCH STREET** to consider the following:

**PUBLIC ART - STAFF PROJECT #15-012; "ARBORING OUR ROOTS OF DIVERSITY" LOCATION: 495 FAIR OAKS AVENUE, IN FRONT OF THE CLARK CENTER AT ARROYO GRANDE HIGH SCHOOL; APPLICANT – FIVE CITIES DIVERSITY COALITION - PUBLIC ART COMMITTEE.** The City Council will consider a public art proposal, "Arboring Our Roots of Diversity", to be located at 495 Fair Oaks Avenue, in front of the Clark Center at Arroyo Grande High School. The purpose of the hearing is to provide an opportunity for the community to comment on the proposal. Prior to the meeting, the art proposal was referred to a public art panel in accordance with the City's Public Art Guidelines.

The Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
