



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

On **TUESDAY, JUNE 14, 2016**, the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at **215 E. BRANCH STREET** to consider the following:

DEVELOPMENT CODE AMENDMENT CASE NO. 16-000002; AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ARROYO GRANDE AMENDING SECTIONS 16.62.010 AND 16.62.050 OF THE ARROYO GRANDE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA CULTIVATION AND AMENDING SECTION 16.62.070 AND ADDING CHAPTER 5.95 TO TITLE 5 OF THE ARROYO GRANDE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA DELIVERY SERVICES. The City Council will consider an Ordinance amending portions of Title 16 and adding Chapter 5.95 to Title 5 of the Arroyo Grande Municipal Code regarding medical marijuana cultivation and medical marijuana delivery services. In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Community Development Department has determined that the project is exempt per Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines. If the City Council does not feel that this determination is appropriate, project approval will not be considered.

The City Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Comments may be either: (1) mailed or delivered in person to the Community Development Department at 300 East Branch Street, Arroyo Grande, CA or (2) provided in person at the public hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
