Do you know how to quilt or want to learn? The City of Arroyo Grande Recreation Services Department is offering Quilting with Barbara Porter. Barbara Porter has a B.S. in Design, an Adult Education credential. She has been teaching quilting for 22 years.

This class has two sessions that meet on Mondays or Thursdays, with room still available in the Monday sessions. The classes meet from 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. Session one meets from January 23<sup>rd</sup> – March 16<sup>th</sup> (No class February 16<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup>) and session 2 meets from March 27<sup>th</sup> – May 18<sup>th</sup> (No class April 17<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup>). Both classes meet at St. John's Lutheran Church, 959 Valley Rd. in Arroyo Grande. This class is for adults and costs \$65 per session.
