NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

On **TUESDAY, MARCH 13, 2018**, the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 215 E. BRANCH STREET** to consider the following item:

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROJECTS FOR YEAR 2018 AND JIM GUTHRIE COMMUNITY SERVICE GRANT PROGRAM ALLOCATIONS. The City Council is requested to review and approve projects to be funded with the City's allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for Year 2018. The City of Arroyo Grande is a participant with the County of San Luis Obispo and other cities therein as an "Urban County" under the Federal Department of Housing and Community Development Block Grant Program. The City Council is also requested to review and approve projects to be funded with the City's local Jim Guthrie Community Service Grant Program funds.

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), it has been determined pursuant to Section 15061(b)(1) of the CEQA Guidelines that the activity is not a project as determined in Section 15378.

The Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
