NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

On **TUESDAY, MARCH 27, 2018** the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at **215 E. BRANCH STREET** to consider the following:

CONSIDERATION OF LOT MERGER 16-001, CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 16-008, AND MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION; CONSTRUCTION OF AN APPROXIMATELY 2,650 SQUARE-FOOT FAST-FOOD RESTAURANT WITH DRIVE-THRU; LOCATION – 727 EL CAMINO REAL (WESTERN CORNER OF EL CAMINO REAL, FAEH AVENUE, AND BELL STREET); APPLICANT – ELA FOODS, INC.; REPRESENTATIVE – KEITH SIMON. The City Council will hold a public hearing and consider an application authorizing the construction of an approximately 2,650 square-foot fast-food restaurant with drive-thru. In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Community Development Department has prepared a draft mitigated negative declaration for the project.

The City Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Comments may be either: (1) mailed or delivered in person to the Community Development Department at 300 East Branch Street, Arroyo Grande, CA or (2) provided in person at the Public Hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
