NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Arroyo Grande Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing on **TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.**, or soon thereafter, to consider the following item:

CONSIDERATION OF CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 20-003, ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW CONFERENCE FACILITY AND COMMERCIAL OFFICES IN AN EXISTING STRUCTURE; LOCATION – 1164 E. GRAND AVENUE; APPLICANT – JOEL RILEY; REPRESENTATIVE – BRYCE ENGSTROM.

The Planning Commission will consider an application to establish an event center that includes a catering kitchen and commercial offices in an existing commercial structure in the Fair Oaks Mixed-Use zoning district.

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Community Development Department has determined the project is categorically exempt per Section 15301(a) of the CEQA Guidelines regarding existing facilities.

Due to concerns regarding the COVID-19 pandemic, the City of Arroyo Grande is conducting all public meetings via teleconference, until further notice. The Planning Commission meeting can be viewed on Government Access Channel 20. The meeting will also be streamed live online from the City's website at www.arroyogrande.org and www.slo-span.org.

Members of the public may submit written comments prior to the meeting via US Mail delivered to the Community Development Department, 300 E. During the public hearing, public comment will be limited to three (3) minutes per speaker, pursuant to current meeting procedure.

The Planning Commission may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
