NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a public hearing on **TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.**, or soon thereafter, to consider the following item:

ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION DECLARING A STAGE 1 WATER SHORTAGE EMERGENCY.

In accordance with Arroyo Grande Municipal Code Section 13.07.030 and California Water Code Section 350 et seq, the City Council will consider adoption of a Resolution declaring a Stage 1 Water Shortage Emergency throughout the area served by the City of Arroyo Grande. The Stage 1 Water Shortage Emergency is based upon a determination that there have been impacts to the City's water supply and/or the City's water supply has or will become so limited that an emergency water shortage condition exists as far as the available water supply being less than projected demand. If adopted, water reductions for residential and commercial water use will be required and will remain in effect for the duration of the Stage 1 Water Shortage Emergency until rescinded or modified by the City Council. Failure to reduce water use by the required amount shall result in the imposition of mandatory financial penalties.


Due to concerns regarding the COVID-19 pandemic, the City of Arroyo Grande is conducting all public meetings via teleconference, until further notice. During the public hearing, public comment will be limited to three (3) minutes per speaker, pursuant to current meeting procedure.

The City Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
