NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a continued public hearing on **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.**, or soon thereafter, to consider the following item:

CONSIDERATION OF APPEAL TO CITY COUNCIL CASE 21-003; APPEAL OF CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 21-005 FOR ADDITION TO AN EXISTING COMMERCIAL STRUCTURE AND ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ART GALLERY AND WINE TASTING COLLECTIVE; LOCATION – 211 E. BRANCH ST; APPELLANT - SHIRLEY GIBSON, ET. AL.

The City Council will consider an appeal of the Planning Commission's approval of Conditional Use Permit 21-005 to construct a 3,108 square foot addition to an existing commercial structure and the establishment of an art gallery and wine tasting collective in the Village Core Downtown zoning district.

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Community Development Department has determined the project is categorically exempt per Section 15332 of the CEQA Guidelines regarding infill development.

Due to concerns regarding the COVID-19 pandemic, the City of Arroyo Grande is conducting all public meetings via teleconference, until further notice. The City Council meeting can be viewed on Government Access Channel 20. The meeting will also be streamed live online from the City's website at www.arroyogrande.org and www.slo-span.org.

Members of the public may submit written comments prior to the meeting via US Mail delivered to the City Clerk, 300 E. Branch Street, Arroyo Grande, CA 93420, or by email to publiccomment@arroyogrande.org. During the public hearing, public comment will be limited to three (3) minutes per speaker, pursuant to current meeting procedure.

The City Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
